Thank you to all that attended our recent Dinner Meeting featuring "Successful Successions", a fireside chat showcasing the faces behind several local businesses that have successfully transitioned ownership to family members. It was an inspiring evening and we are looking forward to hosting other panel discussion groups in the future at our Dinner Meetings.

Vice President Jack Nicholson, Executive Director Colleen Clark and I recently represented our membership at the 2016 Canadian Chamber of Commerce AGM in Regina, Saskatchewan. There were 348 registered delegates who voted on 70 policy resolutions brought forward by Chambers from across Canada. I am pleased to report that the Credit Card Merchant Fee Policy. co-sponsored by the Greater Langley Chamber of Commerce and the Greater Vancouver Board of Trade, was approved by 81.1% of the delegates and will now be in the Canadian Chamber of Commerce policy manual for the next 3 years. This policy takes aim at the ballooning fees and one-sided contracts associated with businesses accepting credit card payments. Canadian merchants currently pay some of the highest credit card and related fees in the world totaling an estimated \$5 billion each year. The resolution offers 4 recommendations on how the Federal Government can take further action and help protect and support Canadian businesses.
